## January 14th Board Meeting

**Board Members present:** President: Alex Raphael, VP: Randy Baisden, Treasurer: Gloria Mellon, Secretary: Gary Hoskins, & Past President: Kurt Schneider. Twenty-one people attended including Board members. The meeting was called to order by the President, Alex Raphael. Gary Hoskins read the minutes from the December board meeting. They were accepted as read. Gloria Mellon gave the Treasurer's report. There is a balance of \$157.00 in the club's account after Xmas party expenses were paid and a deposit of \$250 paid to the graphic designer for the club's new logo.

**Old Business:** Will Bonsell reported on the Website. Bill & Mary Elwell presented a proposal for the Website. The Elwells volunteered to setup the site and run it for free. A motion made by Alex Raphael to have the Elwells be the club's webmasters, seconded by Randy Baisden, voted and unanimously approved. Will Bonsell reported on the club obtaining a PO Box. Discussion whether to have a \$26 dollar small box or a \$47 dollar large box with special numbers (ie: 911 or 944 etc). Alex Raphael made a motion to check into a box with a special number and if not available rent the \$26 dollar box. It was seconded by Gene Williams and approved by a unanimous vote. Gary Hoskins reported on the club logo and presented three preliminary designs with cost of \$500 dollars for a camera-ready digitized design. A deposit was given to Armstrong Graphic Design. Suggestions made include: adding a divider on the highway, snow on the mountain peaks and realistic trees. Gary agreed to check with the embroidery digitizer to assure the design can be sewn as is. Gary reported on the status of incorporation with the state. He reported he had spoken with the states corporation office on the 12th and they said it should be 10 -14 additional days till the club would get the incorporation "OK". He agreed he would file with the IRS soon as we get the state UBI number. Kurt Schneider volunteered to write a letter to various people who have attended club events and invite them to join our new region. Kurt reported that the letter would go out via e-mail and snail mail the week of January 19th.

**New Business:** VP Randy Baisden asked to discuss ideas on club activity fees and fund-raising ideas. Discussion narrowed to Charter Member Name Tags, to keeping the \$5 dollars a car per event, as now exists. A motion by Gloria Mellon, with a second by Kurt Schneider to sell Charter Member Name Tags with the club members name was passed by a unanimous vote. The name tags will be: \$12 pin back and \$15 magnet back. Brooks & Barbara Hanford have the honor of being the first to purchase the new name tags. Kurt Schneider motioned and Alex Raphael seconded a proposal the keep the \$5 per car event charge except when it is deemed necessary to charge a high fee for an event. The example being concours, auto crosses and drivers' education, events that cost more to sponsor. The motion was passed by a unanimous vote. Other new business discussed was the formation of Committees. The following committees were decided and the chairpersons are: Website- Bill & MaryAnn Elwell; Newsletter—Diana Bennett Wirtz; Membership--Gloria Mellon, Data Base—Gene William's. A new Points Committee was discussed, assigning points to people who attend various club events. In October the points will be added up and awards for such things as Club Enthusiast, Club Family, etc. will be awarded. We are looking for a committee head for this committee. If you are interested contact Kurt Schneider.
