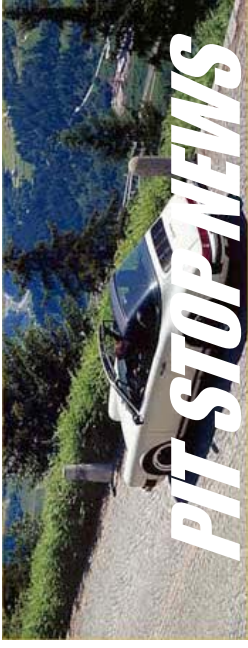

Chuck Saloman tired to save me but I didn't listen!

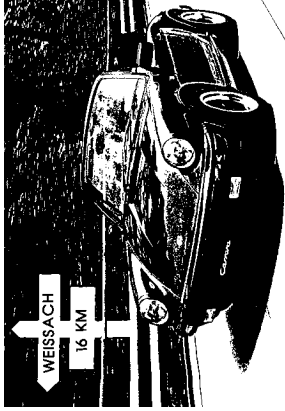
